



# Orange Blossom Klassic

Lamb, Swine & Goat Livestock Show

February 24-25, 2018

GENERAL SHOW RULES



**Notes: It is our determination to give the Youth involved in this show an educational experience in raising and showing their market animals. All animals will be weighed and entered into weight classes. Showmanship will be based on the age of the exhibitor as of January 1, 2017.**

1. Any animal showing evidence of Soremouth, Footrot, Active Club Lamb Fungus, Infectious disease or unsightly conditions will be asked to leave the fairgrounds immediately.
2. All exhibitors must be 5-19 years of age as of January 1, 2018.
3. Entries must be postmarked by: February 14, 2018. Entry fee is \$30 per head. Non-Refundable.
4. **Late Entries will be weighed from 7:30 - 8:00 AM. Late Entry Fee is an additional \$20 per head.**

5. Visa & Mastercard accepted or make checks payable to: Porterville Fair – OBK. Mail entries and payment to:

6. Arrival to fairgrounds will be allowed 12:00 PM to 8:00 PM on Friday, February 23, 2018, and 6:30 AM, Saturday February 24, 2018 & Sunday, February 25 2018.
7. Each exhibitor must show his/her own animal, unless more than one is entered in the same class.
8. Lambs must be slick sheared with no more than 10 days fleece and Goats must be clipped to a maximum of 3/8" prior to weigh-in.
9. Weigh backs may be asked for at the discretion of the judge.
10. Shaving only for bedding. Shavings will be available for purchase on the fairgrounds.
11. Animals to be in place by 8:30 AM.
12. Weigh-in will be from 7:30 - 8:00 AM. Animals must be washed & dried. All blankets-tubes must be removed.
13. **Show delays will be at the discretion of the judge. If an exhibitor has multiple animals he/she must find an alternate current OBK exhibitor to assist them.**
14. Animals must show milk teeth.
15. Market Goats must be slick sheared and disbudded or horns no more than 2" and tipped.
16. Class premiums will be paid on a percentage basis, based on number of animals in class and class placing, only after show expenses are paid.
17. All persons showing must be clean and neatly attired. Collared shirts are MANDATORY. No T-Shirts or Scoop collared blouses allowed, NO EXCEPTION. (Uniforms not required.)
18. The Show Management reserves the right to change the show schedule and classes to improve the show.
19. The ORANGE BLOSSOM KLASSIC and all those associated with the ORANGE BLOSSOM KLASSIC will assume no responsibility for death or injury to livestock or persons nor damage to property of others during those events held at the Porterville Fairgrounds during the period of February 23-25, 2018.
20. **Porterville Fair policy prohibits the use of alcohol on the grounds. No smoking or dogs will be allowed in the barns area. Dogs shall only be allowed on the grounds if they are on a leash. Dog owners must clean up after their dogs and will accept all responsibility for any and all damages that may occur as a result of the animal being on the grounds.**
21. Exhibitors will be allowed to leave after the completion of the show.
22. Lambs, Swine, & Goats will be broken into three class divisions after weigh-in. Divisions will be: Prospect, Progress & Market.
23. There will be four classes for Showmanship.
24. Animal and Exhibitor must be entered in a Jackpot class together to be eligible for Showmanship.
