**PARENT APPROVAL;**

It is understood that the 2021 Heritage Scholarship is based on the following criteria:

1. The applicant must *own and raise* a market hog, lamb, steer or goat project to be sold at the 2021 Porterville Fair. *There will not be a "Heritage Animal" this year.*
2. The market animal project is totally the responsibility of the applicant.
3. The animal must be entered and tagged for the 2021 Porterville Fair by the tagging deadline. (tbd)
4. The animal must make weight and be deemed market ready by the sale date.
5. If the animal fails to make weight or is not market ready at the sale date the applicant will forfeit the 2021 Porterville Fair Heritage Scholarship.
6. Replacement of the applicants' project animal due to injury or death must be done through the Porterville Fair Premium book procedures. There are no exceptions.
7. The \$1,000.00 Porterville Fair Heritage Association Scholarship will be paid to the recipient of the scholarship upon receipt of official transcripts verifying their successful completion of one semester or one quarter of courses from a college or university.
