



# Orange Blossom Klassic

Lamb, Swine & Goat Livestock Show

FEBRUARY 25-26, 2023

GENERAL SHOW RULES



**Notes: It is our determination to give the Youth involved in this show an educational experience in raising and showing their market animals. All animals will be weighed and entered into weight classes. Showmanship will be based on the age of the exhibitor as of January 1, 2023. All exhibitors must be 21 years old and under as of January 1, 2023.**

1. Any animal showing evidence of Soremouth, Footrot, Active Club Lamb Fungus, Infectious disease or unsightly conditions will be asked to leave the fairgrounds immediately.
2. All exhibitors must be 4-21 years of age as of January 1, 2023.
3. Entry fee is \$35 per. Entries received after 11:59 PM February 19, 2023, will be assessed an additional \$20/head late charge. No special provisions for stall space will be made for late entries.

Please call the Fair/Show office at (559) 781-6582 for assistance if required. Entry and late fees are *Non-Refundable*.
5. Arrival to fairgrounds will be allowed 12:00 PM to 8:00 PM on Friday, February 24, 2023, and beginning at 6:30 AM, Saturday, February 25, 2023 & Sunday, February 26, 2023.
6. Weigh-in will be from 5-6 PM Friday & 7:30-8:00 AM Saturday and Sunday. Animals must be washed & dried. All blankets must be removed. Lamb tubes may remain on animals.
7. Each exhibitor must show his/her own animal, unless more than one is entered in the same class.
8. Weigh backs may be asked for at the discretion of the judge.
9. Shaving only for bedding. Shavings will be available for purchase on the fairgrounds.
10. Animals to be in place by 8:30 AM show day(s).
11. ***Show delays will be at the discretion of the judge. If an exhibitor has multiple animals, he/she must find an alternate current OBK exhibitor to assist them.***
12. Animals must show milk teeth.
13. Lambs must be slick sheared with no more than 10 days fleece and Goats must be clipped to a maximum of 3/8" prior to weigh-in.
14. Market Goats must be slick sheared and disbudded or horns no more than 2" and tipped.
15. **Intact Boar hogs will not be accepted.**
16. Class premiums will be paid on a percentage basis, based on number of animals in class and class placing, only after show expenses are paid.
17. All persons showing must be clean and neatly attired. Collared shirts are MANDATORY. No T-Shirts or scoop collared blouses allowed NO EXCEPTION. (Uniforms not required.)
18. The Show Management reserves the right to change the show schedule and classes to improve the show.
19. The ORANGE BLOSSOM KLASSIC and all those associated with the ORANGE BLOSSOM KLASSIC will assume no responsibility for death or injury to livestock or persons nor damage to property of others during those events held at the Porterville Fairgrounds during the period of February 24-26, 2023.
20. **Porterville Fair policy prohibits the use of alcohol on the grounds. NO SMOKING in the barns area. Please be respectful of others and keep dogs out of show ring areas. Dogs shall only be allowed on the grounds if they are on a leash. Dog owners must clean up after their dogs and will accept all responsibility for any and all damage that may occur as a result of the animal being on the grounds.**
21. Exhibitors will be allowed to leave after the completion of the show.

22. **Lamb and Swine will be broken by breed then by weight after weigh-in.**

**BREED ORDER-**

**Sheep:** Dorper, Southdown, Hampshire, Natural, Blackface, Whiteface/Speck

**Hogs:** Berkshire, Duroc, Hampshire, Yorkshire, Light AOB, Dark AOB, Light Cross, Dark Cross

*\*Each hog division must meet a 5 head minimum. If a division does not meet the minimum required entries, the division may be added with less than 5 head if a sponsor comes forward. (\$150.00) If a sponsor does not come forward, hogs in classes with less than 5 entries will be placed in a Light or Dark AOB or Cross class.*

23. Goats will be broken into Prospect (Lightweight), Progress (Middleweight), & Market (Heavyweight) divisions after weigh-in.

24. There will be four classes for Showmanship. Novice (4-8 yrs.), Junior(9-12 yrs.), Intermediate (13-16 yrs.) & Senior (17-21 yrs.)

25. Animal and Exhibitor must be entered in a Jackpot class together to be eligible for Showmanship.
