Orange Blossom Klassic Lamb, Swine & Goat Livestock Show FEBRUARY 22-23, 2025 GENERAL SHOW RULES

Notes: It is our determination to give the Youth involved in this show an educational experience in raising and showing their market animals. All animals will be weighed and entered into weight classes. Showmanship will be based on the age of the exhibitor as of January 1, 2025. All exhibitors must be 21 years old and under as of January 1, 2025.

- 1. Ethical treatment of all animals and ethical conduct from all parties in attendance is expected.
- 2. By exhibiting at the 2025 Orange Blossom Klassic, show management has the right to use all photos and images taken for promotional purposes.
- 3. Vehicles and/or trailers inhibiting the flow or traffic or safety of others, will be removed at the owner's expense.
- 4. All parents, guardians, exhibitors, and associates will treat management, staff, and all others in attendance with respect at all times. If a parent/guardian, exhibitor, and or any associated party is noncompliant with show management's request, they will be asked to leave the grounds immediately and will forfeit any and all entry fees and premiums earned for their associated exhibitor.
- 5. Any animal showing evidence of Soremouth, Footrot, Active Club Lamb Fungus, Infectious disease or unsightly conditions will be asked to leave the fairgrounds immediately.
- 6. All exhibitors must be 4-21 years of age as of January 1, 2025.
- 7. Entry fee is \$40 per class, showmanship \$15 per entry. Entries received after 11:59 PM, Sunday February 16, 2025, will be assessed an additional \$25/per head late charge. Late entries will be accepted online through 11:59 PM, Wednesday February 19, 2025. All late entries following that time and date must be processed in the show office upon arrival. Cash and credit card payments only will be accepted. No special provisions for stall space will be made for late arrivals or entries.
- 8. Entries are being accepted at https://pvfairobk.fairwire.com/.
- 9. Orange Blossom Klassic is sanctioned by Beyond the Ring Junior Livestock Association. For BTRJLA information go to https://btrjla.com/product/2024-membership-entry-cattle-copy/ Membership is NOT required.
- 10. Entry and late fees are Non-Refundable.
- 11. Arrival to fairgrounds will be allowed 12:00 PM to 8:00 PM on Friday, February 21, 2025, and beginning at 6:30 AM, Saturday, February 22, 2025 & Sunday, February 23, 2025.
- 12. Weigh-in will be 5:00-6:00 PM Friday & 7:30-8:00 AM Saturday and Sunday. Animals must be washed & dried. <u>All</u> <u>blankets must be removed. Lamb tubes may remain on animals.</u>
- 13. Weigh backs may be asked for at the discretion of the judge.
- 14. Shaving only for bedding. Shavings will be available for purchase on the fairgrounds.
- 15. Animals to be in place by 8:30 AM show day(s).
- 16. Each exhibitor must show his/her own animal. *If an exhibitor has multiple animals in the same class, he/she must find an alternate current OBK exhibitor to assist them.*
- **17.** Show delays will be at the <u>discretion of the judge</u>. If an exhibitor has multiple animals, he/she must find an alternate current OBK exhibitor to assist them.
- 18. Animals must show milk teeth.
- 19. Lambs must be slick sheared with no more than 10 days fleece. Goats must be clipped to a maximum of 3/8" prior to weigh-in.
- 20. Market Goats must be slick sheared and disbudded or horns no more than 2" and tipped.
- 21. Intact Boar hogs will not be accepted on show grounds.
- 22. Class premiums will be paid on a percentage basis, based on the number of animals in class and class placing.
- 23. All persons showing must be clean and neatly attired. <u>Collared shirts are MANDATORY</u>. No T-Shirts or scoop collared blouses allowed NO EXCEPTION. (Uniforms not required.)

- 24. The Show Management reserves the right to change the show schedule and classes to improve the show.
- 25. The ORANGE BLOSSOM KLASSIC and all those associated with the ORANGE BLOSSOM KLASSIC will assume no responsibility for death or injury to livestock or persons nor damage to property of others during those events held at the Porterville Fairgrounds during the period of February 21-23, 2025.
- 26. Porterville Fair policy prohibits the use of alcohol on the grounds. NO SMOKING in the barns area. Please be respectful of others and <u>keep dogs out of show ring areas</u>. Dogs shall only be allowed on the grounds if they are on a leash. <u>Dog owners must clean up after their dogs and will accept all responsibility for any and all damage that may occur as a result of the animal being on the grounds.</u>
- 27. <u>Stalls must be cleaned following the show.</u> If stall(s) is not cleaned a fine may be deducted from premiums earned OR added to the following year's entry. Used shavings are to be placed on the north/west corner outside of the barn.
- 28. Exhibitors will be allowed to leave after the completion of their show.
- 29. Lambs and Swine will be broken by breed and weight after weigh-in. BREED ORDER-

Sheep: <u>Market Classes followed by Wether Dam Ewe Classes-</u>Dorper, Southdown, Hampshire, Natural, Blackface, & Whiteface/Speck

Goats: <u>Market Classes followed by Wether Dam Doe Classes-</u>Lightweight, Middleweight & Heavyweight (broken by weight)

Hogs: All Black, Berkshire, Duroc, Hampshire, Yorkshire, Cross, & AOB.

NOTE: *Each hog division must meet a 5 head minimum. If a division does not meet the minimum required entries, the division may be added with less than 5 head if a sponsor comes forward. (\$150.00) If a sponsor does not come forward, animals in classes with less than 5 entries will be placed in an AOB class.

- 30. Visible back tags are required by ALL Exhibitors for ring entry. (show provided)
- 31. All dogs must be on a leash and owners are required to clean up after their dogs.
- 32. NO SCOOTERS, BIKES OR BALLS THROWN IN THE BARN AT ANY TIME. Items will be confiscated and not returned.

SHOWMANSHIP:

- 1. Uniforms are not required.
- 2. Animal & exhibitor must have competed together in class to be eligible for showmanship within the same show. (Show A or Show B)
- 3. All exhibitors must show their own animals. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- 4. Showmanship contest Divisions: Novice 4-8 years, Junior 9-12 years, Intermediate 13-16 years, and Senior 17-21 years.
- 5. Fitting is optional for showmanship.
